

Code of Conduct

Members of the Grand Junction Senior Recreation Center shall govern themselves by the following ***Code of Contact***:

1. Members shall treat others with courtesy and respect.
2. Members shall not use profanity, engage in the use of derogatory comments or use language that is abusive, threatening, loud, insulting or harassing.
3. Members shall not fight, encourage others to fight, bully or engage in disruptive behavior.
4. Members shall not deface or damage Center property.
5. Members shall not remove any property from the Center without the permission from the Board.
6. Members shall not steal.
7. Members shall not bring alcohol, illegal drugs or weapons to the Center.
8. Members shall NOT engage in solicitation within the Center.
9. Members shall not make unwelcomed sexual advances, requests for sexual favors and other verbal, physical or visual conduct of a sexual nature.
10. There is absolutely no saving of seats or player spaces at any activity.
11. Members of Grand Junction Senior Recreation Center must be able to care for themselves independently while participating in Center activities.
12. Proper personal hygiene is expected from all members. Please refrain from using strong scents or perfumes.
13. The Center is not responsible for the security, damage or theft of any personal belongings or misplaced items within the Center or on its grounds.
14. The Center is a family. We do NOT support individualized programs that do NOT include all members.
15. Members must govern themselves by the Center's **Code of Conduct**.

Any infraction to the above Code of Conduct may be grounds for a verbal or written warning, suspension or expulsion from the Grand Junction Senior Recreation Center with all rights and privileges thereof.
