As we step into this new year, it's time to roll up our sleeves and get busy doing what we do best—serving others with love and purpose.

We are excited to propose a meaningful outreach opportunity right here in Clayton County at the Calvary Refuge Center, a long-standing ministry that provides shelter and stability for families and individuals experiencing homelessness.

The Calvary Refuge Center has faithfully served our community for decades. The property was purchased in 1997 and thoughtfully remodeled to include a central dining area, kitchen, and 14 living units that resemble modest hotel accommodations for short-term family housing. In 1999, the emergency overnight shelter was dedicated and has since operated year-round, serving the homeless population throughout south metro Atlanta.

Typically, the Center serves 50–60 residents, including approximately 15 children. Dinner begins promptly at **6:30 PM and runs until 7:15 PM**. The Center graciously provides all utensils and paper products. ACMCC would be responsible for providing the meal, dessert, and beverages. Staff members also dine alongside residents to remain engaged and build community.

This is a tangible opportunity for us to extend compassion, nourishment, and hope—one plate at a time. Together, we can make a real difference in the lives of families and children who need it most.
