- V. ***In one short sentence***, what argument do you think the Holy Spirit is making for us here at RBC from **Acts 20:7–12**? How is this same and/or different from question III above?
- VI. What specific goals for growth/change should you prayerfully pursue in light of this passage? Please also pray for Pastor Kitchen in his preparation to preach this text.
