Remember \$2 for our sausage sizzle tomorrow at lunchtime. Sausages will be sold outside near the basketball court.


Families are reminded there are sport vouchers available to the value of \$200 to help cover sport activity costs. To be eligible for a voucher your child/dependant must be:


