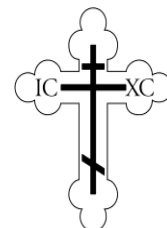
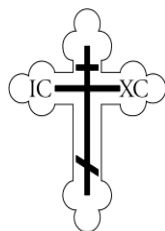

1. Today, Sunday, June 12th: **The Great Feast of Pentecost!**

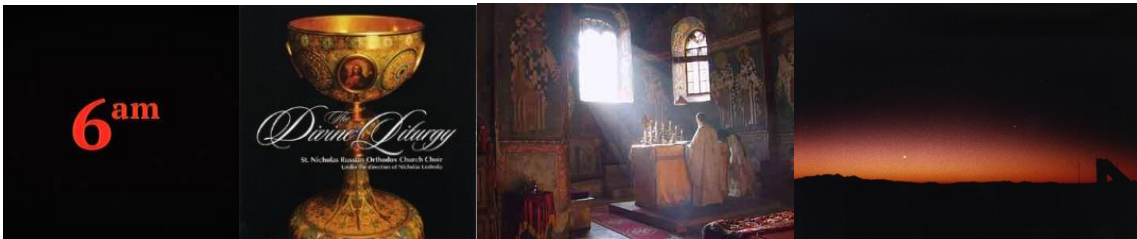

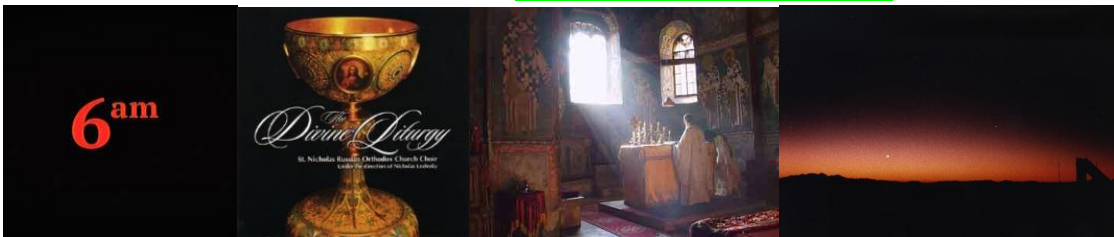
2. **There is no Fasting the whole week following Pentecost!**



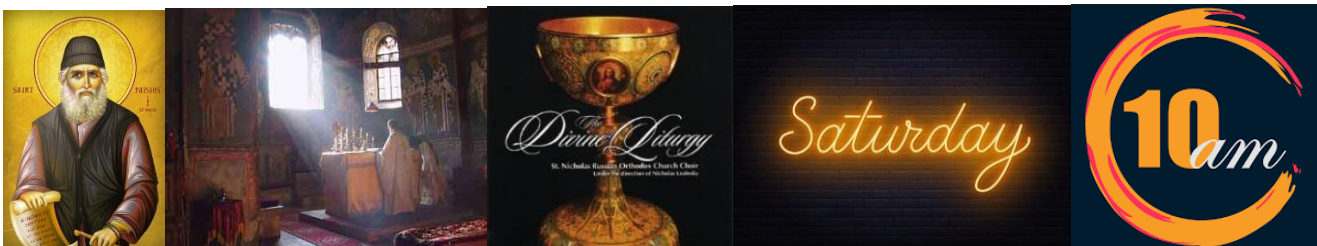
3. Tomorrow, Monday, June 13th @ 6:00 AM: **Early morning Divine Liturgy**

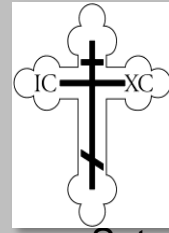


Spiritual Morsels
