



AN OLD MAN WHO LIVED AT TURRES ARDENTLY PRACTICED HOLY POVERTY AND ALMSGIVING. WHEN A BEGGAR APPROACHED HIS CELL ASKING ALMS, THE OLD MAN BROUGHT OUT THE ONLY THING HE HAD - A SINGLE LOAF OF BREAD. THE BEGGAR SAID, "I DON'T WANT BREAD. I NEED CLOTHES." THE OLD MAN, WANTING TO COMFORT HIM, TOOK HIS HAND AND LED HIM INTO HIS CELL, WHICH WAS EMPTY. THE BEGGAR, SEEING NOTHING AND TOUCHED BY THE OLD MAN'S GOODNESS, OPENED HIS WALLET, AND DUMPED EVERYTHING HE HAD ON THE FLOOR. HE SAID, "TAKE THESE, GOOD ABBA, I WILL ASK SOMEWHERE ELSE FOR WHAT I NEED."

MALICIOUS SKEPTICS VISITED **ABBA AGATHON** TO SEE IF THEY COULD ANNOY HIM. THEY HAD HEARD THAT AGATHON POSSESSED GREAT DISCRETION AND SELF-CONTROL. "ARE YOU AGATHON THE HERETIC?" "NO, I AM NOT A HERETIC." "WHY DID YOU PATIENTLY ENDURE IT WHEN WE SLANDERED YOU, BUT REFUSE TO BE CALLED A HERETIC?" AGATHON ANSWERED, "YOUR FIRST ACCUSATIONS WERE GOOD FOR MY SOUL., BUT TO BE A HERETIC IS TO BE SEPARATED FROM GOD. I DO NOT WANT TO BE APART FROM GOD." SAYINGS OF THE DESERT FATHERS

Further, he said, I know monks that have fallen after many toils, and came to an ecstasy of pride, because they put their hope in their works, and were deceived about the commandment which says, ask your father, and he will tell you. **St. Anthony the Great**

When we show our wounds to the doctor, we mention our pains, our troubling, our illnesses without hiding anything, thus also in confession. When someone who is not Orthodox comes to the Orthodoxy Church he [she] must go through the furnace of repentance, of change and regeneration of his entire way of thinking and living. This will take a long time. In order for someone's positive attitude towards Orthodoxy to become an experience of his heart, he must lead a life of asceticism and crucifixion for many years under the guidance of an experienced spiritual father. Otherwise, the "old self" will remain, with the result that unbelief and the inclination to go back to the old way of life will often occur.
