





"Whoever wishes to bear spiritual fruit, let him patiently wage prolonged warfare against sin — so full of various upheavals and troubles. 'At first, she [wisdom] will walk with him on disturbing paths; and bring fear and dread upon him. And she will torment him with her discipline, until she can trust his soul and test him with her ordinances.
