**Lesson 1: Faith That Won't Give Up**

Lesson 1 Text: *(Luke 18:1-8)*

- I. When Jesus returns to the earth, He will be looking for something.
  - A. Jesus wanted us to have faith like this woman.
  - B. If we draw back, God has no pleasure in us. *(Now the just shall live by faith: but if any man draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him. Heb. 10:38)*
  - C. *(Luke 18:1 - AMPC Also [Jesus] told them a parable to the effect that they ought always to pray and not turn coward (faint, lose heart, and give up)*
  - D. Jesus places a high premium on having faith when you pray. If you're going to pray, don't faint, don't turn coward, don't lose heart and run.
  - E. Jesus will be looking for this kind of faith.
- II. The widow would not give up. *(vs. 4-5)*
  - A. You can't try to live by faith, you must do it.
  - B. People who *try* to live by faith don't make it.
  - C. Her continual *tel'os*) coming; means to set out for a definite goal; not a time period, the limit at which a thing ceases to be. Her mindset was, I will come until I reach my goal.
  - D. The judge realized that the woman would not stop until she reached her goal.
- III. Jesus informs His disciples, *(Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If you continue in my word, then are you my disciples indeed: John 8:31).*
  - A. The act of continuing something creates a habit.
  - B. The act becomes habitual.
  - C. We can have good and bad habits.
  - D. When we continue in the Word, we will become a disciple; a *discipline* one.
  - E. Jesus continues in next verse, *(and ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free. John 8:32).*
  - F. Jesus wanted us to understand that faithfulness to God's Word, frees us!!!
- IV. If we decide not to hold on to faith, we can become shipwreck. *(1 Tim. 1:18-19)*
  - A. There are rewards for holding on to your faith. *(Heb. 10:35)*
- V. Faith causes us not to give up, but to seek other means. *(Luke 5:17-26)*
  - A. They did not seek a way; they sought means.
  - B. This faith doesn't stop because one door is shut.
  - C. Don't turn coward, faint, lose heart, and give up.
