Lesson Series Text: *(Mark 4:24-29)*

Lesson 1: Seeds Are For Sowers

Lesson 1 Text: *(Isa. 55:8-13)*

All Scriptures are KJV; unless otherwise noted.

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- I. What do we mean by “Mechanics”?
 - A. The theoretical and practical applications that deals with action of forces.
 - B. The functional and technical aspects of an activity.
 - C. What methodology is needed to produce a desired result.
- II. What is a sower?
 - A. A sower is one who spreads and implants seeds for growth.
- III. In order for sons of God to be successful in the Kingdom of God, we must learn to agree with, practice, and consider the following: (9)
 - A. God’s thoughts – conceptions, considerations, and expectations.
 - B. God’s ways – methods, courses, and progressions.
 - C. Consider how much higher His thoughts and ways are in comparison to ours.
 - a. There are three different heavens: atmospheric, celestial, and God’s Throne.
 - D. The sower’s mind must be renewed to think and act like God’s. *(Rom. 12:2-Do not be conformed to this world (this age), [fashioned after and adapted to its external, superficial customs], but be transformed (changed) by the [entire] renewal of your mind [by its new ideals and its new attitude], so that you may prove [for yourselves] what is the good and acceptable and perfect will of God, even the thing which is good and acceptable and perfect [in His sight for you]. AMPC)*
- IV. God sends His Words to the sowers. (10-11)
 - A. God’s Word is given as a simile (two unlike things are compared) to water.
 - B. The water saturates the earth prompting it to bring forth.
 - a. To give seeds to the sowers.
 - b. To give bread to the eaters.
 - C. The water (word) will cause the earth to produce (prosper) in what it was designed to do.
- V. This whole process releases the captive from bondages and causes the earth to produce. (12-13)
 - A. The earth was placed under a curse and will not yield its ability or potential easily. *(Gen. 3:17)*
 - B. The earth must be forced to produce to the sower.

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- C. This process forces the curse to release the blessing from the earth.
- VI. In order for the sower to be productive; the sower must understand the soils, seeds, seasons, growth patterns, and harvest conditions.
 - A. Soils – You must understand the nature of your soil and soil in general.
 - B. Seeds – You must know the right seeds to sow and what the finished product is to look like.
 - C. Seasons – You must know the right seasons to sow and what are the right conditions to sow.
 - D. Growth Patterns – You must know the growth patterns: watering, weeding, suckling, and the maturation times of the seeds.
 - E. Harvest Conditions – You must know the signs that indicate that the seed has reached maturation and is ready to be harvested.

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
