**Lesson 2: Seeds: You Reap What You Sow**

Lesson 2 Text: *(Gal. 6:6-10 AMPC)*

- I. When we understand the laws and provisions of the kingdom; we will experience abundance in every area.
- II. Sow what you want to reap. (6)
  - A. Quantity and quality.
  - B. Sparingly (*phei-dom-en'-os*) – Stingily, restricted to bare necessity. (2 Cor. 9:6-7)
  - C. Bountifully – over, largeness, reverentially, and adoration. (2 Cor. 9:6-7)
  - D. A large harvest needs a large seed; a small harvest needs only a small seed.
- III. Everything on the earth is regulated by the principle of Seedtime and Harvest. (*Gen. 8:22-While the earth remaineth, seedtime and harvest, and cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night shall not cease.*)
  - A. When God created the first living things; He gave them the ability to reproduce and multiply through the seed. (*Gen. 1:11-12- And God said, Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb yielding seed, and the fruit tree yielding fruit after his kind, whose seed is in itself, upon the earth: and it was so. And the earth brought forth grass, and herb yielding seed after his kind, and the tree yielding fruit, whose seed was in itself, after his kind: and God saw that it was good.*)
  - B. Your life began by the seed principal.
  - C. Every act of your life has been living and growing by the seed principal; be it good or bad.
  - D. In order for us to reach our full potential in life, we must observe the seed principle.
  - E. Don't be deceived; you will reap what you sow.
- IV. Within every harvest there is a seed. (*Gen. 1:12*)
  - A. The seed is the guarantee of a future harvest.
    - a. If we eat or throw away our seed; the cycle of harvest for that seed is broken in our lives.
  - B. The seed is the starting point of our production.
  - C. The seed is a tiny beginning with a huge future.
  - D. The seed is a potential of a yearly supply.

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- V. The seed does not look like the harvest that it produces.
  - A. Don't judge your harvest by the size of your seed.
  - B. Don't forget that little things can birth big things.
    - a. An acorn will give birth to an oak tree.
  - C. If what you have in your hands is not enough; it may be your seed for the full measure.
- VI. A seed planted in good ground has more potential than the seed held in your hand.
  - A. A seed that has left your presence by sowing; has more immediate potential that a thousand stored in your granary.
  - B. Remember, God gives seeds to the sower. (*Isa. 55:10*)
- VII. Every person must recognize their seed that God has stored within them.
  - A. Your skill, talent, or gift that God has provided for you is seed to sow into the life of others.
  - B. God has given you something unique that will give you a future and produce a harvest for you and others.
  - C. A person gift will make room for them. (*Pro.18:16*)
- VIII. What is a seed? A spiritual seed is anything that is given away to increase someone else.
  - A. **The seed** is the Word of God. (*Luke 8:11*)
  - B. Your time is a seed.
  - C. Your money is a seed.
  - D. Your love is a seed.
  - E. Your kindness is seed.
  - F. Your patience is a seed.
  - G. Your time mentoring is seed.
  - H. Your forgiveness is a seed.
  - I. Whatsoever a man sows is a seed.
- IX. While the earth remains, seedtime and harvest. (*Gen. 8:22*)
  - A. The Law of harvest dictates:
    - a. That you reap the very thing that you sow.
    - b. That you reap later than you when you sow.
    - c. That you reap more than what you sowed.
  - B. The seed consists of two parts; the outer husk and the seed.
    - a. The outer husk of the seed (seed coat) feeds the inner portion of the seed (embryo) with nutrients.
    - b. When you sow your seed, the gift (seed coat) meets the immediate need and the (embryo) multiplies back to you what you sowed.
- X. Cast your bread upon the water. (*Ecc. 11:1-6*)
