Lesson 2 Text: (*1 Cor. 10:21-33; Col. 3:17 AMPC*)

- I. To the believer, every place is holy, because God is there. I am not saying that every activity that may be occurring in a given place is holy.
  - A. Therefore, our actions, attitudes, behaviors, thoughts, and words should reflect this belief.
  - B. Whatever we do to the Glory of God, must be done in a spirit that is suitable to fulfill that end.
- II. According to our lesson text, everything we do is to be done in the name of the Lord Jesus.
  - A. Lord Jesus means that Jesus is Lord of our life; therefore He is Lord of everything that we put our hands to.
  - B. In the name of Jesus means in His nature, in His character, and in His person or personality.
  - C. We are to do all things in total dependence on him.
- III. We understand that the profession or vocation of the full time clergy is a holy profession, because it is the administration of holy things of God's Altar.
  - A. However, the things of the market place or business world are not to be considered any less holy.
  - B. Why? Because God is there and because what so ever you are doing, you do it in the name of your Lord Jesus.
- IV. Before God introduced formal worship to man, he introduced work. (*Gen. 1:28; 2:15*)
- V. The word work in the Old Testament has its root in representing God. (*Exo. 20:9-10*)
  - A. The word work in Hebrew is [*melakaw (mel-aw-kaw')*] – Deputyship, i.e. ministry; generally, employment, or work.
  - B. *Melakaw* comes from the root word *mal'ak* – To dispatch as a deputy, a messenger, specifically for God.
- VI. In scriptures, multiple times you will find the word serve and worship together. (*Deu. 4:19; 8:19; 11:16; 30:17*)
  - A. To serve means to labor.
  - B. Whatever you worship; you will labor for it.
  - C. The way you labor, your motive for labor, and the attitude that you labor; is directly related to what you are truly worshipping.

VII. We should do our work, as if at the end of each work day, we are going to present our work to the Lord. (*Eph. 6:5-8*)

- A. The work must be done with certain criteria.
  - a. Be obedient to those over you.
  - b. With fear (*reference*) as unto Christ.
  - c. With singleness of heart.
  - d. Not with eye service as men pleasers.
  - e. As servants of Christ; not the employer.
  - f. Doing the will of God from the heart.
  - g. Doing the service with good will.

VIII. The work or vocation that you are presently assigned to is to be part of your devotion and service to God.

- A. Therefore your work is part of your worship.
