**Lesson 5: If All Prophesy**

- I. Under the New Testament Covenant, God wanted to pour out His Spirit on all flesh. (*Joel 2:28; Acts 2:4*)
  - A. Sons and daughters will prophesy.
  - B. Your old men shall dream dreams.
  - C. Your young men shall see visions.
  - D. Also, I will pour out my Spirit on your servants and handmaids
- II. Previously, prophets, priests, and kings were anointed with oil; a symbol of being separated for a calling of God. In the New Testament, when God pours out His Spirit; it is an enablement of the power of the Holy Spirit for service.
  - A. Under the New Covenant, all believers are kings and priests. (Rev. 1:6)
    - a. The Baptism of the Holy Spirit is for power to be witnesses for Jesus.
    - b. Witness (*mártus*) is one who have information or knowledge of an event, or one who can confirm some information.
  - B. Women, though kings and priests; are questioned by some, whether they are to prophesy in public gathering.
    - a. The answer is yes. (Joel 2:28; Acts 2:4; Acts 21:8-9; 1 Cor. 11:4-5)
    - b. The *anointing to prophesy*, is not given according to gender.
  - C. This was a wish of Moses. (Num. 11:24-29)
- III. Let all things be done for edifying. (1 Cor. 14:22-26)
  - A. Tongues is a sign for them that believe not. (22)
  - B. Prophesying is for those that are believers. (22)
  - C. If all prophesy, and one come in that believes not or are unlearned:
    - a. Is convinced of all. (24)
    - b. Is judged of all. (24)
    - c. Secrets of the heart are made manifest. (25)
    - d. Causes the unbeliever to worship God. (25)
    - e. Report that God is in you of a truth. (25)
- IV. When you come together every one of you have: (26)
  - A. Psalm, doctrine, tongue, revelation, interpretation.
- V. Let all things be done for edifying. (26)
