- I. What is God's will?
 - A. That God's will be done on earth as it is in heaven. (*Mat. 6:9-10 After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.*¹⁰ Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.)
 - B. That everyone might have life abundantly. (John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.)
 - C. That the work of the devil be destroyed. (1John 3:8 He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.)
 - D. That sons of God be anointed with the Holy Ghost, so that the Lord can use them to heal. (*Mark 16:17-18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.*)
 - E. That believers prosper and be in health. (3 John 1:2 Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.)
 - F. That believers be doers of the word. (Jam. 1:22 But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.)
- II. Strangers to the covenant. (*Read Eph. 2:11-19*)
 - A. Definitions
 - a. Aliens estrange, shutoff, excluded.
 - b. Commonwealth citizenship or common sharing.
 - c. Strangers foreigners, without a common share.
 - B. Because we were excluded from citizenship in Israel and foreigners to the covenants; we had <u>no hope</u> and were <u>without God</u>.
- III. Abraham's seed. (*Read Gal. 3:6-9, 13-17, 26-29*)
 - A. We are the children of Abraham. (7)
 - B. God preached the gospel to Abraham. (8)
 - C. We are blessed with faithful Abraham. (9)
 - D. Christ removed the curse. (13-14)

- a. Curse of Sin (2 Cor. 5:21)
- b. Curse of Sickness (1 Pet. 2:24)
- c. Curse of Poverty (2 Cor. 8:9)
- E. The blessings of Abraham are ours. (Gal. 3:14)
- F. Christ removed the curse of the law; that the blessing of Abraham might come on us through faith.
 - a. Since sin brought death and sickness into the world; sin must be removed before healing can take place.
 - b. Jesus death secured our forgiveness. (Col. 1:14)
- G. Abraham covenant still exists. (Gal. 3:17)
- H. We are the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus. (Gal. 3:26)
- I. We were baptized into Christ. (Gal. 3:27)
- J. Because we are in Christ, we are Abraham's seed. (Gal. 3:29)
- IV. The children's bread belongs to us. (But Jesus said unto her, Let the children first be filled: for it is not meet to take the children's bread, and to cast [it] unto the dogs. Mark 7:27)
 - A. Ought not this child of Abraham be loosed? (*Read Luke 13:10-16*)
- V. The Gospel includes healing. (*Read the scriptures below*)
- VI. Jesus healed them all. (*Read the scriptures below*)

The Gospel Includes Healing.

Matthew 4:23 - And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people.

Matthew 9:35 - And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.

Luke 4:18 - The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised. *Luke 9:1-2 -* Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over all devils, and to cure diseases.² And he sent them to preach the kingdom of God, and to heal the sick.
