

By signing below, I agree to the following regarding the Belize Mission Trip from January 4, 2024, through January 13, 2024.

Code of Conduct:

- 1. The purpose of this trip is to work, regardless of age; we expect each team member to contribute daily to the projects at hand to the best of their ability, with a good attitude. The trip is a work trip and could include, but is not limited to, the following kinds of work: cleaning, painting, general "building repairs," using small hand tools, digging, etc.
- 2. Elevate Ministry requires each team member to conduct themselves respectfully, lovingly, and appropriately. While on this trip, you are representing Elevate Ministry and its values. Our goal is to help the country we visit by working hard and setting aside our desires and wants. Be prepared to work as a team.
- 3. Refrain from using tobacco, tobacco products, drugs, alcohol, and inappropriate, derogatory, or foul language.
- 4. Modest dress is required. Shorts may not be any shorter than mid-thigh, no leggings or yoga pants, shirts must cover your midriff even with arms raised over your head, swimsuits must be modest (girls: 2 piece or tankini, but must cover midriff at all times, swim shorts; boys: no speedo).
- 5. Please use the buddy system at all times. If you are 18 or under and we are in a public place, you must always have someone with you, and a group leader must know if you are going somewhere. Our goal is to keep everyone safe. If you are over 18, please notify someone else on the team if you are going somewhere and preferably take someone with you. Please do not wander off on your own. At the Bed and Breakfast, if you are 15 or older, you can be on your own inside the facilities, but make sure one of your roommates knows where you are at all times and you are conducting yourself appropriately.
- 6. Please remember that we are guests in Belize and the KenMar Bed and Breakfast. Be respectful of the facilities, those who work there, and the rules they ask you to follow. Keep in mind that there may be other guests that are not part of our group staying there at the same time. Be mindful of keeping the noise down and being considerate to them. Children 14 and under must be with a parent at all times.
- 7. We believe that growing in Christ is a part of this trip and growing together as a team. Each evening we will be holding a debriefing of the day and a short devotional. All team members are expected to attend.
