RULES UPDATE 2019

How to Take Relief

Determine "Reference Point"

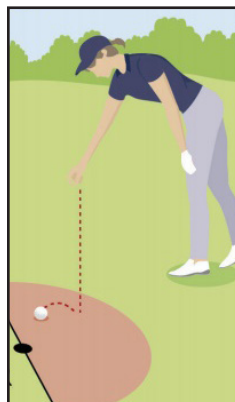
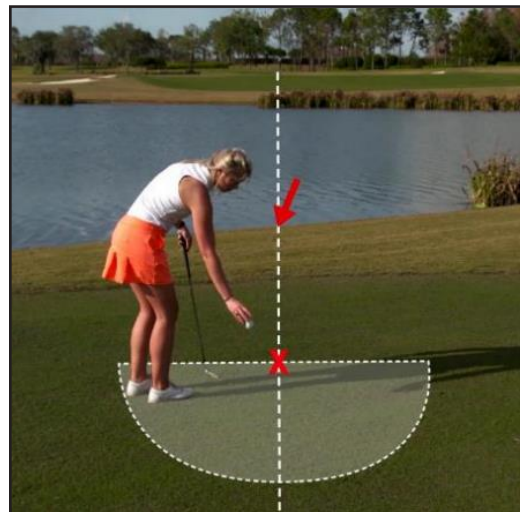
- Nearest point of complete relief, point ball last crossed edge of penalty area, point chosen for back-on-the-line relief, spot where the previous stroke made for stroke-and-distance

Determine the "Relief Area"

- 1 or 2 club lengths (using longest club in bag besides the putter) from the "Reference Point," no closer to the hole.

- In this picture: line from where ball entered water to hole (red arrow), back on that line to chosen "Reference Point"

(red X); "Relief Area" is half circle made by 1 club length arc from "Reference Point."



Dropping a ball in "Relief Area"

- Ball must be dropped from knee height
- Must first land in the Relief Area and stop in Relief Area

Ball dropped "Wrong Way"

- Did not land in relief area
- Not dropped from knee height
- Hit player/equipment first
- Must be redropped (unlimited times)
- Ball not coming to rest in Relief Area – drop, drop, place
