PETITION FOR BAIL UNDER SECTION 480 OF BNSS, 2023

The Petitioner humbly submits before this Hon'ble Court as follows:

1. The address for service of all notices and processes on the Petitioner is that of his Learned counsel,
2. The Petitioner submits that the Respondent Police have registered a case in Crime No. for the alleged offences under Section . The Petitioner was arrested on and was thereafter remanded to judicial custody.
3. The Petitioner submits that he is innocent and has not committed the offences alleged against him. The Petitioner has been falsely implicated in the above case and the allegations levelled against him are denied as false and incorrect.
4. The Petitioner submits that the allegations made against him are denied as false and incorrect. The prosecution is required to establish the essential ingredients of the alleged offences through legally admissible

evidence. The mere registration of the case cannot by itself justify the continued incarceration of the Petitioner.

5. The Petitioner submits that no useful purpose would be served by keeping him in continued judicial custody. The Petitioner is ready and willing to cooperate with the investigation and to appear before the Respondent Police as and when required.

6. The Petitioner submits that he is a permanent resident of and has a fixed place of residence. Therefore, there is no possibility of the Petitioner absconding or fleeing from the process of law. His presence can always be secured by imposing appropriate conditions.

7. The Petitioner submits that he undertakes not to tamper with the evidence or influence, threaten or induce any prosecution witness in any manner whatsoever.

8. The Petitioner further undertakes that he shall not involve himself in any offence while on bail and shall strictly comply with all the conditions that may be imposed by this Hon'ble Court.

9. The Petitioner submits that he is ready to execute sufficient sureties to the satisfaction of this Hon'ble Court and is also ready to abide by any condition imposed by this Hon'ble Court while granting bail.

10. The Petitioner submits that continued detention of the Petitioner is unnecessary and would cause serious hardship to him and his family. The Petitioner therefore prays that this Hon'ble Court may exercise its discretion in his favour and enlarge him on bail.

Therefore, it is prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to grant bail to the Petitioner/Accused in pending investigation on the file of the Respondent Police and thus render justice.
