## 1 RULES

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2021–2024* (RRS) as changed by *Appendix E Radio Sailing Racing Rules*, the regatta's *Sailing Instructions* and *Class Rules* of the individual classes.
- 1.2 The following Class Rrules are published in the US VMYG website (https://usvmyq.org/classes/).
  - Skipjack 48
  - Schooner (over 50 inches and under 50 inches)
  - International A Boat (pre 1994 boats)
  - 10 Rater
  - Unrestricted Model
  - Vintage 36/600
  - Vintage Marblehead (Traditional, High Flyer, and Classic)



## 2 ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 Membership in the US Vintage Model Yacht Group is required.
- 2.2 Membership in the American Model Yachting Association is encouraged.
- 2.3 Skippers of Remote Control (R/C) Skipjacks, Schooners, International A Boats, 10 Raters, Unrestricted Model yachts, Vintage 36/600s, and Vintage Marbleheads.

3.4 Saturday, Sept 14 Vintage 36/600 Skippers' Meeting: 0900 hours, Racing all day.


**Barbeque Dinner**: 1700 hours at the regatta site.

## 7 FLEET MANAGEMENT AND SCORING

- 7.1 Our objective is to safely sail as many races as can be comfortably accommodated. Considering the number of skippers, weather, course and equipment conditions, the Race Director may decide to use a racing format of Single Fleet, or the Odd Even System for Regatta Fleets described in the Sailing Instructions.
- 7.3 The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A shall apply, using one point as the lowest score. Marbleheads and Vintage 36//600 will have one high score race discarded from each boat's overall score for each eight races sailed. For all other classes, one high score race shall be discarded from each boat's overall score.
- 7.4 Skippers shall come prepared for wet launch and wet retrieval of their yachts from the boat ramp.

## **8 COMPETITORS WITH DISABILITIES**

- 8.1 The Chicago RC Model Yacht Club aims to reasonably accommodate all competitors. However, the outdoor regatta site may present some limitations.
- 8.2 The onus is on the competitor to establish whether the available facilities are adequate before deciding to enter the event. Competitors that require any form of help or special requirements should contact the Registrar before submitting an entry to determine if the host club is able to help with the provision of any such special requirements.
- 8.3 Be prepared for wet launching of your boat.
