

# Veterans Memorial Park Rules



## ALL CAMPERS MUST STOP AT THE OFFICE BEFORE ENTERING CAMPGROUND

### CHECK IN & REGISTRATION INFO

- Online Registration only! Walk-ins will only be allowed if space is available and approved by staff. **Do not help yourself to a campsite!**
- Daily rates are **\$35** per night/per unit plus tax and a registration fee of **\$10**.
- Campsite **check-in 1 p.m.** and **check-out 11 a.m.**
- If you cancel no later than 7 days before the date of the reservation, you'll be credited a refund of camping fee, but not the registration fee. No refunds for early departures.
- For late departure, please check with office.
- **Quiet Hours:** 10:00pm- 6am.
- Office hours: Saturday and Sunday 9:00am – 4:00pm, Monday – Friday call the main office for assistance 715-478-3475
- You must be at least 18 years of age with a valid I.D. to register for a campsite.
- We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone.

### SITE RULES:

- Camping receipt/permit must be available if requested by staff.
- One additional camping unit will be allowed per site but must fit on designated camping pad. Additional camping unit will need to be checked in at office and pay nightly camping fee.
- Campsites may be rented a maximum of 14 consecutive days, check with office if you wish to extend your stay.
- After dark (during quiet hours) bicycle riding is prohibited. Parents are responsible for their children at all times and should accompany them when traveling to restrooms or leaving their campsite.
- Campfires are allowed and must be attended to at ALL times. Do not remove fire ring from pad!
- Do not take tables or grills from other sites.
- Water Supply is available to campers.
- No camping units or vehicles on grass.
- Do not move fire rings or picnic tables from pad

### TRASH / RECYCLING: Located near garage

- Burning or dumping garbage, debris or anything other than clean wood is prohibited.
- Campers are responsible to deposit all garbage in dumpsters.

- Campers are responsible to separate recyclables and deposit in designated bins.

### BATHHOUSE / RESTROOM:

- Children must be supervised by an adult when using the shower and restroom facility.

### PETS:

- All pets must be kept on leash and under adult supervision at all times.
- Pets should NEVER be left unattended at campsites (example: tied to trees or campers).
- Please clean up all droppings.
- For a complete set of rules see “**Enjoying the park with your pet**”.

### VEHICLE RULES:

- Vehicles of registered campers are allowed inside of campground. **Visitor(s)/non-registered vehicles must park in main parking lot and walk in.**
- Visitor(s) with a handicap sticker in vehicle may enter campground.
- Speed limit throughout the campground is 5mph and is strictly enforced.
- Road is ONE-WAY.
- Be aware of small children playing in roadway.
- Absolutely **NO** ATVs, or UTVs, allowed in campground.
- Golf carts and scooters are allowed but must be operated by a licensed and insured driver.

### OTHER:

- Fireworks are prohibited.
- Do not park boats or jet skis on the beach or in swimming area.
- Pressure washer is available to wash boats and trailers.
- Firearms are prohibited in the campground

### EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS:

- Designated Severe Weather Shelter is the Bathhouse/Restroom
- AED and First Aid Kit are available at Office Building

**Campers violating these rules can be subject to immediate removal without refund from the campground and be further subject to denial of future use.**
