ENJOYING THE PARK WITH YOUR PET

Veterans Memorial Park welcomes your special members of your family; however, we have a few rules and requests to make sure that they, you and our other guests, who enjoy a pet free vacation are comfortable, safe and happy.

KEEP YOUR PET ON A LEASH:

- Pets must be on a leash no longer than 8 feet at all times.
- Pets should be under adult supervision at all times.

PETS MUST BE UNDER CONTROL:

- Pet owners who fail to properly control their pet(s), or whose pet creates a public nuisance may be asked to leave.
- Excessive barking is prohibited.
- Pets should NEVER be left unattended at campsites (examples: tied to a tree or inside camper)

DISPOSE OF WASTE PROPERLY:

- The Park has several dog stations throughout the park equipped with bags and waste baskets.
- Pet owners are responsible for proper removal and disposal of their pet(s) droppings. Droppings should be disposed of in dumpsters or trash receptacles.

AREAS OFF LIMITS TO PETS

Pets are **NOT** allowed in the following places:

- Buildings
- Playground areas
- Designated sandy beach and swim areas
- Other campsites

AREAS PETS ARE ALLOWED

Pets are allowed in the following places:

- In your rented campsite
- Blacktop road
- Grassy beach area

EXERCISING YOUR PET IN THE WATER:

- The park has designated the following area to exercise your pet:
 - West side, near boat landing, opposite of beach area (see park map).
- All pets **MUST** have adult supervision when unleashed in water.

OWNERS:

Pet owners are responsible for the actions of their pets. Pets that cause damage to private and or public property or attack other pets or people will be grounds for immediate removal of the pet. Pet owner is financially responsible for any damage or medical bills as a result of their pet's actions.
