## The Ontario Secondary School Diploma

30 credits are required for graduation

- 4 Credits in English (1 credit per grade)
- 3 Credits in Mathematics (1 credit in Grade 11 or 12)
- 2 Credits in Science
- 1 Credit in Canadian History
- Credit in Canadian Geography
- Credit in French as a Second Language
- 1 Credit in the Arts
- 1 Credit in Health & Physical Education
- 0.5 Credit in Civics
- Credit in Career Studies
