CANDIDATE CAMPAIGN RULES - STATE BOARD & NATIONAL DELEGATE

These defined rules have been created to ensure that all candidates have equal rights.

Campaigning:

The following rules and regulations are of utmost importance and will be applied to all candidates equally.

- 1. One vendor table will be available to rent per candidate at each state-level meeting. a. Available meetings Spring Booster, Fall Booster, and State Convention
- 2. Cost per candidate \$50.00 per event
- 3. Vendor tables must be requested through the State President, and the candidate or representative must pay for the table at least 30 days before the meeting.

- b. Please specify "Campaign Vendor Table" on the memo line.
- 4. No outside food or beverage allowed. If you wish to purchase food and/or beverages from the hotel, the candidate is responsible for directly coordinating with the hotel and purchasing said items.
- 5. The MIRLCA will honor all reasonable requests to distribute campaign literature at the candidate's expense. For details, contact the MIRLCA Secretary.
- 6. Candidates running for State Officer and/or National Delegate may advertise in the state newsletter, The Michigan Rural Letter Carrier.
 - a. There is a word limit. Only the allowable number of words will be published. The statement will end at the limit if a submission exceeds the allowable number of words.
 - i. National Delegate Candidates There is a limit of 25 words.
 - ii. State Officer Candidates There is a limit of 75 words.
 - b. Each year, the newsletter's first issue will include a call for candidate statements.
 - i. All instructions will be published at this time.
 - c. The Candidate's statements will be published in the 2nd issue of the newsletter each year.
