Regular Monthly Board Meeting Minutes

The regular monthly board meeting of the Town of Bloomington was called to order on Monday June 4<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at 7:00 P.M. by Chairman Greg Patterson. Roll call was taken and members present were Chairman Greg Patterson, Town Supervisors William Erdenberger, Joe Kirschbaum, Clerk Jane Patterson and Patrolman Andrew Crubel. Public member in attendance was Michelle Newhouse. Greg Patterson made the motion, seconded Joe Kirschbaum to approve posting of the June meeting notice and agenda, motion carried. William Erdenberger made the motion, seconded by Greg Patterson to approve the May meeting minutes, motion carried.

There were no appearances/Public comments.

Chairman Greg Patterson talked to Matt Vincent of Vincent Excavating about rebuilding the narrow area of Dugway Road. Greg was told it would cost around \$60,0000.00 or more to build a retaining wall for a 50' stretch of road that could eventually get wiped out by another mud slide. The board decided to discuss different options with Patrolman Andrew Crubel on how to widen narrow sections of Dugway Road. One option would be to grade dirt from the hillside over to the bank side, another option would be to roll trees down the bank where they would catch between other trees to help hold back dirt and rock. Patrolman Andrew Crubel will put up more reflective posts at the narrow areas and the board agreed that signs stating "One Lane Road Ahead" should be posted at both ends of the Town of Bloomington's section of Dugway road. Andrew Crubel will get these signs ordered and installed. Gravel is needed on Dugway Road to fill in washed out areas and Sandy Hollow/Walnut Roads need reshaping in specific areas. The mower cover is in bad shape and needs replacing, the board unanimously approved Andrew to order a new cover.

Clerk Jane Patterson shared a letter received from Michelle Olson, WTA Grant Co Unit Chair, on new ATV/UTV rules for operations on County roads. The County would like all municipalities to adopt these changes into their ATV/UTV Ordinances. The Clerk also shared a letter from Matthew Honer about the 2018 Hazard Mitigation Plan. This Plan, once it is approved by FEMA, will be adopted by the County and will be required by each municipality to also approve the plan in order to be eligible for FEMA funds.

Clerk Jane Patterson presented the May financial report. All outstanding bills were presented; Greg Patterson made the motion to pay all outstanding bills, Bill Erdenberger seconded the motion, motion carried.

Greg and Andrew will try to get the downspout on the Township Hall building fixed within the next couple of weeks. Water has been seeping in the Northeast corner of the building due to no downspout and saturated ground.

The next regular Monthly Board Meeting will be held Monday July 9<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at 7:00 PM.

Chairman Greg Patterson made the motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Joe Kirschbaum, motion carried.
