Resolution Declaring Emergency

The Town Board of the Town of Bloomington, Grant County Wisconsin, by this resolution, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, resolves and orders as follows:

An emergency is declared as existing within the Town of Bloomington, Grant County, Wisconsin, for the following reasons: There is an imminent threat of damage that impairs transportation at Mango Hollow on Dugway Road.

The period of emergency shall be limited to the time during which the emergency conditions exist or are likely to exist in the Town of Bloomington

The Town Board has the authority to order whatever is necessary and expedient for the health, safety, welfare, and good order of the Town of Bloomington during the emergency, including without limitation the power to bar, restrict and remove all unnecessary traffic, vehicular or pedestrian from the local highway.

Sec. 60.47(5) provides that public contracts are not subject to the normal purchasing and competitive bidding requirements because of the emergency.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, the Bloomington Town Board is authorized to enter into a public contract with Thoma Concrete - Dubuque, IA as defined under Sec. 60.47(1) & Sec. 60.47(5) Wis. Stats., with an estimated cost of the public contract to the town of more than \$5,000.00 but not more than \$25,000.00, to be executed by the Town Board for the repair of continuous flood damage at Mango Hollow on Dugway Road.

This resolution goes into effect upon passage and posting.
