Monday August 6th, 2018
Regular Monthly Board Meeting Minutes

The regular monthly board meeting of the Town of Bloomington was called to order on Monday August 6th, 2018 at 7:00 P.M. by Chairman Greg Patterson. Roll call was taken and members present were Chairman Greg Patterson, Town Supervisors William Erdenberger, Joe Kirschbaum, Clerk Jane Patterson and Patrolman Andrew Crubel. Public member in attendance was Michelle Newhouse. Greg Patterson made the motion, seconded Joe Kirschbaum to approve posting of the August meeting notice/agenda, motion carried. William Erdenberger made the motion, seconded by Joe Kirschbaum to approve the July meeting minutes, motion carried.

No Appearances/Public comments.

Chairman Greg Patterson talked to Dan Tomah of Tomah Concrete about pouring cement on Dugway Road at Mango Hollow on Monday August 13th. Greg will also talk to Steve Adrian after their monthly meeting to see if they still want cement poured on Dugway Road in the Glen Haven Township. The road will need to be closed for several days to give the cement time to cure. Patrolman Andrew Crubel has put up one of the narrow road signs, and has been hauling cement from Dave Mergen's place down to Dugway Road to keep the bank from eroding. Heavy farm equipment has torn up an intersection and other places in the sealcoat, Andrew Crubel will watch for continuing damage from farm equipment and may have to notify the owners. Flood repairs on Holly, Cottonwood & Elm Roads are complete. The grader cylinder has been repaired and put back on. Andrew will call Fabco about the bill; labor charges on the invoice are questionable.

Clerk Jane Patterson presented the July financial report. All outstanding bills were presented; Greg Patterson made the motion to wait and pay outstanding Fabco and Tandem Tire bills until after the vendors have been called with questions about the invoice amounts, Bill Erdenberger seconded the motion, motion carried. Clerk Jane Patterson also informed the board of the WEM flood damage amount that was reported to the county and state. Total damages came to \$12,192.17, with total possible reimbursement of \$8,534.52.

Greg Patterson made the motion to pass the Transportation Resolution that was sent to all municipalities from the WTA, seconded by Joe Kirschbaum, motion carried unanimously. This resolution will then be sent to State Legislators and Governor Scott Walker to encourage increased funding in the State Budget for road maintenance.

The next regular Monthly Board Meeting will be held Monday September 10th, 2018 at 7:00 PM and the August Partisan Primary will be held at the town hall on August 14th, 2018.

Chairman Greg Patterson made the motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by William Erdenberger, motion carried.
