Monday September 10th, 2018
Regular Monthly Board Meeting Minutes

The regular monthly board meeting of the Town of Bloomington was called to order on Monday September 10th, 2018 at 7:00 P.M. by Clerk Jane Patterson, Chairman Greg Patterson was absent. Supervisor Joe Kirschbaum nominated Bill Erdenberger, seconded by Jane Patterson to chair the meeting. Members present were Town Supervisors William Erdenberger, Joe Kirschbaum, Clerk Jane Patterson and Patrolman Andrew Crubel. Public member in attendance was Michelle Newhouse. Bill Erdenberger made the motion, seconded Joe Kirschbaum to approve posting of the September meeting notice/agenda, motion carried. William Erdenberger made the motion, seconded by Joe Kirschbaum to approve the August meeting minutes, motion carried.

No Appearances/Public comments.

Patrolman Andrew Crubel reported that the cement swale has been poured on Dugway Road. An Apron on the west side of the swale will need to be poured to keep the water from cutter underneath the cement. Dugway and Sandy Hollow Roads have been graded, some areas on Sandy Hollow will need gravel next year. Roads and machinery are in good condition; Andrew Crubel is getting the mower ready to cut the road ditches/banks. Greg and Andrew need to arrange a meeting with Kenny Meyer of Mississippi Mountain Condo to go over roads that will need snow plowing this winter. Andrew will take care of ordering salt and grit for the winter. Trent Pritchett's cattle are getting into Bart White's grain field due to a fencing issue. Supervisor Bill Erdenberger signed the Township's WI DOT certified road map.

Clerk Jane Patterson presented the August financial report. All outstanding bills were presented; Bill Erdenberger made the motion to pay outstanding bills, Joe Kirschbaum seconded the motion, motion carried. Clerk Jane Patterson showed the board the WI DOR's 2018 Statement of Changes in Equalized Values by Class and Item. The residential category has increased by 9% from last year. Assessor Angela Adams said she wrote to the DOR about this increase. FEMA paperwork has been finalized, we are eligible for reimbursement, but payment date has not been established. Clerk Jane Patterson has been in contact with WEM about the Township's 2018 flood damage application. Proof of employee paychecks, gravel payment, time cards, and machine rental payment needed to be resubmitted before WEM could finish the reviewing process of our application. Jane has not heard back from WEM as to whether they have accepted our application.

The next regular Monthly Board Meeting will be held Monday October 1st, 2018 at 7:00 PM.

Bill Erdenberger made the motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Joe Kirschbaum, motion carried.
