Monday October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018  
Regular Monthly Board Meeting Minutes

The regular monthly board meeting of the Town of Bloomington was called to order on Monday October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018 at 7:00 P.M. by Chairman Greg Patterson. Members present were Chairman Greg Patterson, Town Supervisors William Erdenberger & Joe Kirschbaum, Clerk Jane Patterson and Patrolman Andrew Crubel. No Public members were in attendance. Greg Patterson made the motion, seconded by Joe Kirschbaum to approve posting of the October meeting notice/agenda, motion carried. Greg Patterson made the motion, seconded by Joe Kirschbaum to approve the September meeting minutes, motion carried.

No Appearances/Public comments.

Patrolman Andrew Crubel reported that due to heavy rains today, road closed signs will need to be put up. He will recheck roads tomorrow and start repairing those that are damaged. An Apron on the west side of the swale on Dugway Road has been poured. Andrew is working on getting the machinery ready for winter use. Salt from the County must be picked up by November 1<sup>st</sup>; salt from the County will not be available during the winter months. Greg and Andrew will arrange a meeting possibly this week with Kenny Meyer of Mississippi Mountain Condo to go over roads that will need snow plowing this winter. The Board agreed that if Township residents need a driveway sanded or plowed, there will be a minimum charge of \$25.00. Depending on how much sand is needed or how long the driveway is, the charge could exceed \$25.00.

Clerk Jane Patterson presented the September financial report. There are no outstanding bills to be paid at this time. Assessor Angela Adams has informed Clerk Jane Patterson that the Township's Revaluation will take place 2019/2020 rather than 2018/2019. Angela does not have the current basis numbers for assessing and she should have them by next year. The board discussed the 2019 preliminary budget and tax levy. Greg Patterson made the motion, seconded by Bill Erdenberger to pass the IOH Ordinance #11-2018, on a voice roll call the motion carried yes-3, no-0. Greg Patterson made the motion, seconded by Bill Erdenberger to approve the new Recycling Contract with Faherty Incorporated, on a voice roll call the motion carried yes-3, no-0. The General Election will be on Tuesday, November 6<sup>th</sup> at the town hall.

The next regular Monthly Board Meeting will be held Monday November 5<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at 7:00 PM at the town hall. The Budget Hearing and Special Electors Meeting for the Tax Levy will be held Wednesday, November 14<sup>th</sup>, at 7:00 PM at the town Hall.

Greg Patterson made the motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Joe Kirschbaum, motion carried.
