Monday November 5th, 2018
Regular Monthly Board Meeting Minutes

The regular monthly board meeting of the Town of Bloomington was called to order on Monday November 5th, 2018 at 7:00 P.M. by Chairman Greg Patterson. Members present were Chairman Greg Patterson, Town Supervisors William Erdenberger & Joe Kirschbaum, Clerk Jane Patterson, Patrolman Andrew Crubel and public member Michelle Newhouse. Greg Patterson made the motion, seconded by Bill Erdenberger to approve posting of the November meeting notice/agenda, motion carried. Bill Erdenberger made the motion, seconded by Joe Kirschbaum to approve the October meeting minutes, motion carried.

Appearances/Public comments: Michelle Newhouse talked to Chris Johll about a new fire number for 10614 Pine Lane and she would also like a "Slow Children at Play" sign. Patrolman Andrew Crubel will order the signs. The Township will pay for the fire number sign and Michelle will pay for the "Slow Children at Play" sign.

Greg Patterson made the motion to increase Patrolman Andrew Crubel's wage to \$19.00 an hour, Bill Erdenberger seconded the motion, on a voice roll call (yes-3, no-0) motion carried. The increase will take effect January 1st, 2019. A retirement plan for Andrew was mentioned, the board will discuss this item next year when planning the 2020 budget.

Joe Kirschbaum made the motion to appoint Jane Patterson for a second 3 year term as Town Clerk, Bill Erdenberger seconded the motion, Greg Patterson abstained from the vote, motion carried. Jane was sworn in for the new term by Chairman Greg Patterson.

New gravel has been applied to parts of Sandy Hollow Road and Utah Road has been repaired in two places that had been torn up by farm machinery.

The grader is at Fabrick in Madison for transmission repair. Estimate time for repair is still two weeks out.

Clerk Jane Patterson presented the October financial report. Greg Patterson made the motion to pay all outstanding bills, seconded by Bill Erdenberger, on a voice roll call (yes-3, no-0) motion carried. The board discussed the 2018 tax levy and 2019 budget. The tax levy for 2018 will remain the same as 2017, no increase.

The General Election will be held tomorrow at the town hall from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm.

The Public Budget Hearing and Special Electors Meeting for the Tax Levy will be held Wednesday, November 14th, at 7:00 pm at the town Hall and the next monthly board meeting will be December 3rd, 2018 at 7:00 pm.

Greg Patterson made the motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Joe Kirschbaum, motion carried.
