RECYCLING COMPLIANCE ASSURANCE PLAN
RESOLUTION #09092019

Purpose: This policy will establish standard guidelines that will lead to compliance with the Town of Bloomington's recycling ordinance.

The Town Board of the Town of Bloomington is responsible for enforcing the Town of Bloomington's recycling ordinance. Town of Bloomington staff and personnel shall follow the guidelines identified in this Compliance Assurance Plan in response to issues associated with recycling and solid waste. This Plan is intended to meet the requirements of s. NR 544.04 (9g), Wis. Adm. Code as well as Town of Bloomington's recycling ordinance.

Problem: Unacceptable materials found mixed with recyclables and recyclable materials found in trash.

Compliance Strategy:


First Response: Recycling Attendant explains what is and is not acceptable and provides educational materials to resident.


Second Response: Continued occurrences shall result in the Recycling Attendant rejecting unacceptable material and informing the Town Board in writing and verbal communication of non-compliance. The Town Board will write a letter to the resident, enclose educational material, and follow up with a telephone and/or in person contact.

Third Response: If compliance is not achieved, a member of the Town Board shall issue a citation per code.

The Town Clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required under Wisconsin State Stats 60.80.
