Regular Monthly Board Meeting Minutes-Unapproved

The regular Monthly Board Meeting of the Town of Bloomington was called to order on Monday, February 2nd, 2026, at 7:00 pm by Chairman Bill Erdenberger. Roll call was taken, other members present were Supervisor I Mike Patterson, Supervisor II David Mergen, Clerk Jane Patterson and Treasurer Brenda Kluesner. Patrolman Andrew (Buck) Crubel was not present. Motion (Mike Patterson) second (David Mergen) was made to approve the posting of the February 2nd meeting and Agenda, motion carried. Motion (Mike Patterson) second (David Mergen) was made to approve the January 5th monthly board meeting and January 15th special board meeting minutes, motion carried.

Roads and Machinery Reports: Chairman Bill Erdenberger reported that he has talked to Buck about the power steering problem regarding the Town's white pickup truck. Bill and Buck will start looking for a used pickup truck to replace the current one. Roads being considered for seal coat in 2026 are Ash Lane, Aspen West, Cedar Lane, Hickory West, Holly West, Walnut East and Hoffman Lane-along with the roads/intersections that were damaged by the installation of the utility poles. Mike Patterson received emails from Jewell Engineering stating the type of information they will need to include with the Wis DOT ARIP application. Information such as testimony from area residents near the bridge as to why the bridge needs to be maintained/repaired due to the amount of traffic that uses the bridge. All other roads and machinery are in good winter condition.

Treasurer and Clerk Reports: Treasurer Brenda Kluesner presented the January Financial Report and Clerk Jane Patterson reported that there were two outstanding bills. The board unanimously approved the financial report and payment of bills. Clerk Jane Patterson will inform David Mergen when the virtual Board of Review training will take place (either March 30th or 31st).

Old or New Business: Clerk Jane Patterson informed the board [to keep in mind] that there will be elections held in April, August and November when scheduling the cement pad for the Town Hall. Clerk Jane Patterson has talked to Michelle Newhouse about the buoy situation at Jay's Landing. Michelle will take care of this matter.

The next board meeting will be on Monday, March 2nd at 7:00 pm at the Bloomington Town Hall

Motion (Bill Erdenberger) seconded (David Mergen) was made to adjourn the meeting at 7:53 pm, motion carried.
