

TOWN OF BLOOMINGTON
ANNUAL MEETING MINUTES
TUESDAY, APRIL 19TH, 2022

The Town of Bloomington held its Annual Town Meeting Tuesday, April 19th, 2022 at 7:00 p.m. in the Bloomington Town Hall pursuant to Wis. Stat. 60.11(2)(a).

Greg Patterson called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Board members in attendance were: Greg Patterson, Joe Kirschbaum, Bill Erdenberger and Clerk Jane Patterson; no other Town Electors were present.

Greg Patterson made the motion to vote by voice, Bill Erdenberger seconded the motion, on a voice roll call motion carried.

Greg Patterson made the motion to approve the 2021 Annual Town Meeting Minutes, Joe Kirschbaum seconded the motion, on a voice roll call motion carried.

Jane Patterson made the motion to grant the Town Board the authority to borrow money in an emergency or when needed, Greg Patterson seconded the motion, on a voice roll call, motion carried.

Greg Patterson made the motion to authorize the Town Board to budget \$2,000.00 for Highway Matching Aid with the County, Joe Kirschbaum seconded the motion, on a voice roll call, motion Carried.

Greg Patterson made the motion to authorize the Town Board to budget money for the control of weeds within the town, Bill Erdenberger seconded the motion, on a voice roll call motion carried.

Clerk Jane Patterson presented the 2021 Annual Financial Report. Greg Patterson made the motion to approve the 2021 Annual Financial Report, Bill Erdenberger seconded the motion, on a voice roll call, motion carried.

Clerk Jane Patterson discussed with the board raising the compensation paid to election officials to \$11.00 an hour (current pay per hour is \$10.00). The pay increase would take effect January 1st, 2023. Since no action can be taken on this discussion, it will be put on the May Monthly Town Board Meeting agenda.

Greg Patterson made the motion to set the date for next year's Annual Town Meeting on Tuesday, April 18th, 2023 pursuant to State Statute 60.11(2)(a), Joe Kirschbaum seconded the motion, on a voice roll call, motion carried.

Greg Patterson made the motion to adjourn the 2022 Annual Town Meeting, Bill Erdenberger seconded the motion, on a voice roll call, motion carried.
