## Township of Bloomington 2023 Budget Hearing Minutes November 7<sup>th</sup>, 2022

Chairman Greg Patterson called the Budget Hearing to order at 6:30 pm. All town board members were present and clerk Jane Patterson. One public member was in attendance.

Motion (Bill Erdenberger), seconded (Joe Kirschbaum) to approve posting of the Budget Hearing, motion carried.

The budget was reviewed and discussed. Clerk Jane Patterson noted that the overall Budget for 2023 will increase 21.3% over the 2022 Budget due to the final payment on the loader tractor and the use of ARPA funds for Seal Coating Maine Road. The funds to pay for the tractor will come from the Equipment Fund Account. The Township also saw a slight increase in the Intergovernmental Revenues as the General Transportation Aid from the DOT increase by almost \$5,000.00. The 2022 Tax Levy will remain neutral.

The 2023 Town of Bloomington Budget will be adopted by the Town Board at the December 5<sup>th</sup>, 2022 monthly board meeting.

Motion (Greg Patterson) seconded (Joe Kirschbaum) to adjourn the Budget Hearing, motion carried.
