Monday February 3rd, 2020
Regular Monthly Board Meeting Minutes

The regular monthly board meeting of the Town of Bloomington was called to order on Monday, February 3rd, 2020 at 7:00 PM by Chairman Greg Patterson. Members present were Chairman Greg Patterson, Town Supervisors William Erdenberger & Joe Kirschbaum, Clerk Jane Patterson and Patrolman Andrew (Buck) Crubel. A public member was in attendance. Motion (Bill Erdenberger), seconded (Joe Kirschbaum) to approve posting of the February meeting/agenda notice, motion carried. Motion (Greg Patterson), seconded (Bill Erdenberger) to approve the January 6th Board Meeting minutes, motion carried.

Public comments: Clerk Jane Patterson commented that she was asked by someone on the Bloomington Fire Department if the Township had a contingency plan in case of an emergency. This question brought up the subject of a generator; if the Town hall needed a generator Greg Patterson and Andrew Crubel each have one the Hall could use.

Roads: Patrolman Crubel named the roads that will need seal coating this summer: Ash Lane, Hoffman Lane, Holly Rd West, Pine Lane (depending on the outcome of the MLS program), Aspen Rd West, Walnut Rd (between Maine and Texas Rds) and Cedar Lane. Advertising for seal coat bids will be in the local newspaper early March. Clerk Jane Patterson showed a letter to the board from WTA on the chances of getting money from the MLS program. There are “1030 applications from towns with a total project value of \$568 million dollars competing for \$28.7 million dollars. Only 5% of the project funding request will receive assistance, award amounts are expected to be announced the end of February”.

Machinery: Patrolman Crubel used the new grappler on Sandy Hollow Road to clear away fallen trees stating the grappler cut his labor time in half to move the trees. The black Town Truck’s parking brake is still not working since the repair, Warco will look at the problem.

Clerk Jane Patterson presented the January financial report and all outstanding bills. The board unanimously approved payment of bills. The board members will need to be trained this year for the board of review; Clerk Jane Patterson will order the 2020 training material. There will be an election at the Town Hall on February 18th, the Spring Primary.

The next monthly board meeting will be March 9th, 2020 at 7:00 pm at the Town Hall.

Motion (Greg Patterson), seconded (Joe Kirschbaum) to adjourn the meeting, motion carried.
