Regular Monthly Board Meeting Minutes

The regular Monthly Board Meeting of the Town of Bloomington was called to order on Tuesday, January 4th, 2022 at 7:00 pm by Chairman Greg Patterson. Other members present were Town Supervisors Bill Erdenberger, Joe Kirschbaum, Clerk Jane Patterson and public member Michelle Newhouse. Patrolman Andrew (Buck) Crubel was not present. Motion (Bill Erdenberger), seconded (Joe Kirschbaum) was made to approve posting of the January meeting/agenda notice, motion carried. Motion (Greg Patterson), seconded (Bill Erdenberger) was made to approve the December Monthly Board Meeting minutes, motion carried.

There were no Appearances/Public Comments.

Roads & Machinery Reports: The roads and machinery reports were not available due to the absence of the patrolman.

The board looked over the Town's business and workers compensation insurance policy (carried by Rural Mutual Insurance) before approving payment.

Motion (Greg Patterson), seconded by (Bill Erdenberger) was made to raise the part-time employee's compensation from \$15.00 an hour to \$17.00 starting immediately, on a voice roll call yes-3, no-0, motion carried.

Financial Report: Clerk Jane Patterson presented the December 2021 financial reports. There was one outstanding bill which the board approved payment. The Clerk and Town Board members looked over the end of the year bank account balances and the adopted/actual 2021 budget final figures.

Old Business: Motion (Greg Patterson), seconded (Bill Erdenberger) was made to renew the buoy placement contract with Greg Page and raise the compensation for placement from \$400.00 to \$500.00 per year, on a voice roll call yes-3, no-0, motion carried.

Changing the Treasurer's position from an elected to an appointed position will be discussed at the next monthly board meeting.

Future Meetings: The next regular Monthly Board Meeting will be Tuesday, February 1st, 2022 at 7:00 pm at the Town Hall.
