Monday March 11th, 2019  
Regular Monthly Board Meeting Minutes

The regular monthly board meeting of the Town of Bloomington was called to order on Monday March 11<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at 7:00 PM by Chairman Greg Patterson. Members present were Chairman Greg Patterson, Town Supervisors William Erdenberger & Joe Kirschbaum, Clerk Jane Patterson, Patrolman Andrew Crubel, and public member Michelle Newhouse. Motion (William Erdenberger), seconded (Greg Patterson) to approve posting of the March meeting/agenda notice, motion carried. Motion (William Erdenberger), seconded (Joe Kirschbaum) to approve the February Board meeting minutes, motion carried.

Patrolman Andrew Crubel reported that the roads are in good condition. The winter weather has been hard on some of the roads' edges and will need patching this summer. The replacement parts for the spinner on the orange truck are here, but have not been put on. The grader is not experiencing any problems since its last repair and the black truck is working fine. Greg Patterson talked to Price Equipment about the loader tractor's float position for the bucket not working. Price Equip. will take a look at it. Carl from Scott's Construction called Andrew Crubel and said he will be sending someone to measure roads for a seal coat bid. Roads being considered for seal coat maintenance this year are Ash and Hoffman Lanes, Cottonwood, North Texas, Utah, Ohio, and West Holly Roads

Clerk Jane Patterson presented the February financial report and informed the board that WEM has granted the Township \$8,507.10 in disaster funds for the 2018 flooding. Motion (Greg Patterson) seconded (Joe Kirschbaum) to pay all outstanding bills, on a voice roll call, motion carried yes-3; no-0. Motion (Greg Patterson), seconded (Joe Kirschbaum) to accept J&N's bid for gravel, on a voice roll call, motion carried yes-3; no-0. Motion (Greg Patterson), seconded (Bill Erdenberger) to charge \$50.00 each for a "Class B" & Class "B" liquor license, on a voice roll call, motion carried yes-3; no-0. Motion (Greg Patterson), seconded (Joe Kirschbaum) to charge \$10.00 for a two year Operator's/Bartender's License, on a voice roll call, motion carried yes-3; no-0.

Clerk Jane Patterson presented a letter received from WI DSPS stating that a municipality may choose to exercise jurisdiction over the inspection of electrical wiring installations. The board agreed to leave that job to the building inspector. The spring election is three weeks away; all board members and treasurer are on the ballot.

Next Monthly Board meeting will be Monday April 1st, 2019 and the Annual Meeting will be Tuesday April 16<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at the Township Hall, 7:00 PM.

Motion (Greg Patterson), seconded (Joe Kirschbaum) to go into closed section to discuss Assessor Proposals for Revaluation, on a voice roll call, motion carried yes-3; no-0.

Reconvened in open session. Motion (William Erdenberger), seconded (Joe Kirschbaum) to hire Gardiner Appraisal Service, LLC to conduct the Township's Revaluation and continue on as the Township's assessor, on a voice roll call, motion carried yes-3; no-0.

Motion (Greg Patterson), seconded (Joe Kirschbaum) to adjourn the meeting, motion carried.
