Regular Monthly Board Meeting Minutes

The regular Monthly Board Meeting of the Town of Bloomington was called to order on Monday May 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2022 at 7:00 pm by Chairman Greg Patterson. Other members present were Town Supervisors Bill Erdenberger, Joe Kirschbaum, Patrolman Andrew (Buck) Crubel, Clerk Jane Patterson and public member Michelle Newhouse. Motion (Bill Erdenberger), seconded (Joe Kirschbaum) was made to approve posting of the May meeting/agenda notice, motion carried. Motion (Bill Erdenberger), seconded (Greg Patterson) was made to approve the April Monthly Board Meeting minutes, motion carried.

Appearances/Public Comments: None

**Roads & Machinery Reports:** Patrolman Andrew (Buck) Crubel reported that roads are in good condition. Walnut Rd will need some patching. Carl, from Scott's Construction, will be coming here sometime this week to look at Birch Road. Bob Steiger called and asked Greg and Buck to look at an area where Bob took out a culvert and would like to put a larger one back in its place. The damage done to Birch Road is on the edge of the road approximately 3 feet wide by .2 of a mile long. Wedging the road will repair the damage. The technician for the grader is coming tomorrow to look at the valves. Buck ordered more skids for the new mower to keep it from tearing up the edges of the road when mowing the road ditches and banks.

**Financial Report:** Clerk Jane Patterson presented the April 2022 financial reports. There was one outstanding bill, the board unanimously agreed on payment. Clerk Jane Patterson discussed with the Board amending the budget to correct the Seal Coat Expense Account. Motion (Greg Patterson), seconded (Bill Erdenberger) was made to take \$8,000.00 from the Highway Maintenance Expense Account and put it into the Seal Coat Expense Account, on a voice roll call, Yes-3, No-0, motion carried. The board also discussed taking money from the Contingency Fund to pay for the repairs on Birch Road. The ARPA funds will be used next year for a road project. Clerk Jane Patterson sent a Liquor License renewal application to the Blake Hollow Barn. Motion (Greg Patterson), seconded (Joe Kirschbaum) was made to pay election officials \$11.00 an hour starting January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023, on a voice roll call, Yes-3, No-0, motion carried.

**Future Meetings:** The next regular Monthly Board Meeting will be Monday, June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2022 7 pm at the Town Hall.
