Monday May 6th, 2019
Regular Monthly Board Meeting Minutes

The regular monthly board meeting of the Town of Bloomington was called to order on Monday May 6th, 2019 at 7:00 PM by Chairman Greg Patterson. Members present were Chairman Greg Patterson, Town Supervisors William Erdenberger & Joe Kirschbaum, Clerk Jane Patterson, Patrolman Andrew Crubel, and public member Michelle Newhouse. Motion (Greg Patterson), seconded (Bill Erdenberger) to approve posting of the May meeting/agenda notice, motion carried. Motion (Bill Erdenberger), seconded (Joe Kirschbaum) to approve the April Board meeting minutes, motion carried.

Patrolman Andrew Crubel reported that he has been applying cold patch on damaged areas of the roads; Sandy Hollow and Dugway Roads have been graded. He has not heard from Scott's Construction as to when the selected roads will be seal coated. Work on Dugway Road will continue this spring/summer moving dirt from the bank where slides have occurred over to the ditch and dumping cement/rock to secure it. The valve stack on the grader is leaking and will eventually need repairing; the old orange truck has a broken leaf spring and is being fixed at Tyler's Repair in Mount Hope. We have received the WisDOT's request for the 2019 Road Pavement Ratings. Pavement rating information is due by December 15th.

Clerk Jane Patterson presented the April financial report. The Board unanimously approved paying all outstanding bills. Motion (Greg Patterson), seconded (Joe Kirschbaum) to grant and issue a Class "B" & "Class B" liquor License to Blake Hollow Barn. Clerk Jane Patterson will attend the next Grant County Board meeting in Lancaster on May 21st, Command Central will attend this meeting to discuss a plan and bring the new voting machines for the County Board Members and Municipal Clerks to see. The goal is for both the County and the Municipalities to work together in purchasing these machines. If an agreement is made, the new machines will be implemented in time for the 2020 elections. Gardiner, the Township's new assessors beginning January 1st, 2020, will hold an introduction session before the September 9th regular board meeting approximately 6:30 pm. They will explain their procedures for the Township's total revaluation that will take place starting January 1st, 2020 and their yearly maintenance assessment processes. Open book was held May 4th, no one attended.

Board of Review will be Monday May 13th, 2019 from 7:00 pm – 9:00 pm at the Township Hall. The next regular monthly board meeting will be Monday June 3rd, 2019 7:00 pm at the Township Hall.

Motion (Greg Patterson), seconded (Bill Erdenberger) to adjourn the meeting at 8:50 pm, motion carried.
