

Bloomington Township
Public Hearing Minutes
September 2nd, 7:15 PM

A Public Hearing of the Town of Bloomington was called to order by Chairman Greg Patterson September 2nd, 2020 at 7:15 pm. Roll call was taken and members present were Chairman Greg Patterson, supervisors Bill Erdenberger, Joe Kirschbaum and Clerk Jane Patterson. Public members in attendance were: Bart White, Wendy Myers, Brad/Jane White, Terry Mergen, Louie/Sue Recker and Pam Henkel.

Motion (Bill Erdenberger), seconded (Joe Kirschbaum) was made to approve the class 3 publication of the Public Hearing, motion carried.

A Public Hearing was held in regards to the Lay Out of a Public Way referred to as the Extension of Hickory Road. Discussion was held between members present and the board on several issues. Wendy Myers asked about a culvert that had been removed and if it would be replaced. Chairman Greg Patterson explained that the culvert was plugging with debris causing the water to run over the road and wash the gravel away. The sides of the road had to be ditched to keep water flowing alongside the road and not over the road. Another culvert will not replace the one that was taken out. Louie Recker said that the turnaround at the end of the road was on his property, Chairman Greg Patterson explained that the Township has 33' from the center of the road as a right of way and since it is a dead end road, there needs to be a place to turn the Town truck around. There was also discussion of plowing the road this winter. All landowners will receive a copy of the Survey of Plat of Hickory Road from Clerk Jane Patterson.

Motion (Greg Patterson), seconded (Joe Kirschbaum) to adjourn the Public Hearing, motion carried.
