Regular Monthly Board Meeting Minutes

The regular Monthly Board Meeting of the Town of Bloomington was called to order on September 6<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at 7:00 pm by Chairman Greg Patterson. Other members present were Town Supervisors Bill Erdenberger, Joe Kirschbaum, Patrolman Andrew (Buck) Crubel and Clerk Jane Patterson. Motion (Bill Erdenberger), seconded (Joe Kirschbaum) was made to approve posting of the September meeting/agenda notice, motion carried. Motion (Greg Patterson), seconded (Bill Erdenberger) was made to approve the August Monthly Board Meeting minutes, motion carried.

**Roads & Machinery Reports:** Roads are in good shape. The board and patrolman discussed the findings of the Salt Storage report. The mixture ratio of grit and salt remains at the level where we are allowed to maintain a salt pile that is not stored in a shed. Chairman Greg Patterson signed the Wisconsin DOT GTA map to certify the roads that we are receiving aid on. Machinery is in good condition. Patrolman Buck mentioned that the water has been off at the garage for several days due to the work being done on the waterlines by the Village of Bloomington.

**Financial Report:** Clerk Jane Patterson presented the August 2022 financial reports. There were no outstanding bills. The board and Clerk briefly discussed using the ARPA money for a road project in the 2023 budget. Further discussion on the 2023 budget will take place at next month's board meeting. Clerk Jane Patterson reported that the Wisconsin State Historical Society has name an area out on Kishwaukee Trail as an Indian Burial Ground.

Patrolman Buck will talk to the Grant County Highway Department about making a sign for the Burton Cemetery.
