Regular Monthly Board Meeting Minutes Unapproved

The regular Monthly Board Meeting of the Town of Bloomington was called to order on Tuesday, September 8th, 2026, at 7:00 pm by Chairman Bill Erdenberger. Roll call was taken, other members present were Supervisor I Mike Patterson, Supervisor II David Mergen, Patrolman Andrew (Buck) Crubel, Clerk Jane Patterson and Treasurer Brenda Kluesner. Motion (Bill Erdenberger) second (Mike Patterson) was made to approve the posting of the September 8th meeting and Agenda, motion carried. Motion (Mike Patterson) second (David Mergen) was made to approve the August 3rd monthly board meeting minutes. No public appearances.

The board discussed the formation of the Comprehensive Plan Committee. Clerk Jane Patterson suggested that the committee be formed before the end of the year.

Roads and Machinery Report: Buck has been mowing road banks. Marks in the roads caused by the company putting in the fiber optic cable are not too bad-will use chips and/or cold patch to repair. The large tree that went down on Nola Sitt's property and onto Dugway road/right-of-way is too big for us to remove. Buck will keep cutting it back to keep the road and right-of-way clear. Thirteen loads of regular gravel/three loads of blue gravel will be spread on Dugway Rd and two loads of blue gravel will be spread on Sandy Hollow Rd. Buck has talked to the quarry people on Hickory Rd that their gravel piles are too close to the road and in the right-of-way. He has asked them to move them back, as of Monday the piles have not been moved. Machinery is in good condition, Buck replaced batteries in the Kenworth Town truck and will need to purchase some tools. Our parking lot was dug up due to a water leak in Sloan's parking lot. Three separate waterlines tee off one shut-off valve under our parking lot (Sloans, Price Equipment & Town of Bloomington Garage/Hall). The Village of Bloomington will have to decide what to do about this situation.

Treasurer and Clerk Reports: Treasurer Brenda Kluesner presented the August Financial Report. Clerk Jane Patterson presented the outstanding bills. Motion (Bill Erdenberger) second (David Mergen) was made to approve of the financial report, motion (Bill Erdenberger) second (Mike Patterson) was made to approve payment of the outstanding bills, on a voice roll call, yes-3, no-0, motions carried.

Old or New Business: Motion (Bill Erdenberger) second (David Mergen) was made to adopt Resolution #2026-0908 [repeal and replace Section IV of Ordinance #2018-7-9 regarding ATV/UTV Vehicles], on a roll call, yes-3, no-0, motion carried. Motion (Mike Patterson) second (David Mergen) was made to adopt Ordinance #2018-7-9 amended by resolution #2026-0908, on a voice roll call, yes-3, no-0, motion carried. Motion (Bill Erdenberger) second (David Mergen) was made to accept Brad Smrcina's Building Inspector's contract, on a voice roll call, yes-3, no-0, motion carried. Board members, clerk, treasurer and patrolman looked over the 2026 budget income/expenses to date and the preliminary 2027 budget. Discussions on the 2027 budget will continue at the next monthly board meeting.

Motion (Bill Erdenberger) seconded (Mike Patterson) was made to adjourn the meeting at 8:15 pm, motion carried.
