Items that cannot be towed should not be stored in the storage lots. All items should be mobile and easily moved.

Topics for Discussion:

1) Annual Meeting: The format and agenda for the Annual Meeting will follow the same schedule as last year.

- 2) Block Captains: The current Block Captains are being contacted to inquire if they want to continue in that role.
- 3) POA Association Disclosure Notices: As part of the POA packet that is forwarded to the realtor/seller of property in MVS to be distributed to the buyers, the <u>Association</u> <u>Disclosure Notice</u> is a document to be signed by the buyers and returned to MVS as an acknowledgement that the buyers have been advised of their HOA responsibilities. A new procedure must be implemented to ensure that the buyer's completed/signed document is forwarded to MVS HOA promptly.
 - Therefore, special notice will be given to the realtor/seller that this document must be completed by the buyers and returned to MVS Treasurer or Vice President prior to settlement closing. The realtor/seller will be advised that the MVS Treasurer will not forward information to the Title Agency unless this document has been executed and forwarded to MVS HOA.
- 4) Additions to MVS Guidelines: The MVS attorney has been contacted to review and recommend actions regarding the trash can issue.
