CHOOSE YOUR INSTRUCTIONAL PATH

PATH 1: Climate & Behavioral Management

This path focuses directly on the practices and processes of creating a school-wide climate and culture that is positive, engaging, and absent of threat. These three days will take you on a journey of understanding how the brain learns best when placed in a environment that is designed for collboration, novelty, and creativity.

You will study:

- How to build self-efficacy in your students through modeling and language
- Classroom design strategies to increase productivity based on brain science
- Structures to use for building inclusion and strong relationships within your
- Daily tools to use in lowering anxiety, increasing engagement, and building
- Practices used to integrate leadership and character traits into your daily instruction
- Behavioral intervention strategies to use for situations when students are struggling with behavioral expectations

PATH 2: Curriculum & Instructional Delivery

This path focuses directly on the practices and processes of how to teach the way the brain learns. These three days will take you on a journey of understanding how the brain learns best when using engaging curriculum and a strong framework for lesson delivery.

You will study:

- How to create a yearlong mindmap from your standards that organizes and engages your students
- Interleaving tools you can use throughout the day to review past learning, assess, and introduce new lessons
- Engagement strategies to use during your direct instruction to "hook" your students into the lesson
- Collaboration structures to use with students to process information and skills to long-term memory
- Novel practices students can use to demonstrate their knowledge and skills in meaningful and creative ways
- The interworkings of the brain and learning and how it can become the foundation of your teaching practice
