Tailbone from Dogwood Racing

- 1. Mount the TailBone, with aluminum flat bar base, to the rear of the subframe using the supplied 6mm fasteners.
- 2. Before installing the springs, set your tail in place and mark the two large quarter turn holes on the underside of the tail. Place your tail upside down on a workbench and drill the center of your marks with a 1/8" pilot bit from the inside. Set tail back into position to confirm proper placement of the two pilot holes you just made.
- 3. Set the tail on workbench, and from the outside in, drill both pilot holes to size using a step bit (or uni bit). A standard drill bit of this size can crack the fiberglass, step bits work best.
- 4. Use the supplied pop rivets to install the two springs on the underside of the TailBone.
- 5. Install the tail. If the fasteners are loose, a shorter stud can be used or you can add washers under the coil of the spring. If the fastener is tight, a longer stud can be used or you can squeeze the coils of the springs. Fiberglass and carbon panels have varying thicknesses, not every application will be the same.
