

TRIGGER SWITCH INSTRUCTIONS

IMPORTANT SAFETY RULES TO FOLLOW

- REMOVE ALL BULLETS FROM VICINITY OF GUN AND SHOOTER.
- ALWAYS CHECK AND EMPTY GUNS OF AMMO BEFORE INSERTING THE LASER SPUD INTO THE MUZZLE OF YOUR GUN.
- NEVER FIRE YOUR GUN WITH LIVE AMMO WHEN THE LASER IS INSTALLED BECAUSE IT WILL RESULT IN THE DESTRUCTION OF THE GUN AND POSSIBLE DEATH OR INJURY TO THE SHOOTER OR BYSTANDERS.

Two trigger switches are supplied with each Pistolero – the Finger Ring (which fits on your trigger finger) and the Trigger Attachment Switch (which hooks directly onto the trigger) – to accommodate all types of pistols, which have different trigger guards, and all types of shooters, who have different hand sizes. Use the trigger switch that works best for you.

1. **The Finger Ring with MicroSwitch.** Adjust the finger ring to fit your trigger finger and set the microswitch so that, when the trigger is squeezed, it activates the switch/laser light.



2. **The Trigger Attachment Switch** fits over your trigger. When the switch mounted on the gun trigger is squeezed it activates the switch/laser.

Enjoying Your Pistolero

Almost anything is possible when you spend enough time in practice.

Your Pistolero gives you the opportunity to practice “shooting” using your own gun, anywhere, at anytime, becoming proficient -- and all without the bang or the \$buck!

Target

Spend leisure periods of time aiming your gun at your selected target. 15 minutes is a typical practice session and doing this 3 or 4 times a week will add amazing skill to your shooting ability.

Instinct & Tactical - The RIFT (Real Instant Feedback Training) System

Finding range time can be difficult. The Pistolero allows the practicing shooter to employ the RIFT system of personal training. Even in one's own home, the practical use of the shooter's own gun in tactical and instinct situations – shooting in the dark, around corners, up stairwells, on your knees or belly – is very real and the shot result is displayed every time the trigger is pulled by the Pistolero's bright red laser.

The Pistolero was not designed to be used from the holster.
