The book includes a timeline of the product drops along with the head sculpt names and their use for different dolls up to 2016.

The book is out of print and was not made available in digital format. As more and more collectors depend on the internet for information, this book may become more valuable as an instand reference guide to the beginnings of a now very successful doll company.
