28 TO THE HONORABLE COURT, ALL PARTIES, AND THE ATTORNEYS OF RECORD:

1 The Motion for Final Approval of the Class-PAGA Action Settlement came before this
2 Court at 10:00 a.m., on April 22, 2021, in Department 11 of the Los Angeles Superior Court -
3 Spring Street Courthouse, located at 312 North Spring Street, Los Angeles, CA 90012.

4 The Court, having reviewed and considered the Motion for Final Approval of Class-PAGA
5 Action Settlement filed by Plaintiff and Class-PAGA Representative, Hun Park, the memorandum
6 of points and authorities and declarations submitted in support thereof, any opposition and/or
7 objection thereto, the Amended Joint Stipulation of Class Action Settlement And Release, the
8 Notice of Proposed Class Action Settlement, and all pleadings, files and records with the Court in
9 this action, including, but not limited to Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Approval and
10 supporting pleadings, as well as the application of controlling case precedent and statutory
11 authority, and good cause appearing, the Court entered an Order granting said Motion.

12 In accordance with said Order and the Amended Joint Stipulation of Settlement and
13 Release upon which is based, judgment in this Class-PAGA Action is hereby entered as follows:

14 **JUDGMENT**

15 Pursuant to the Order Granting Final Approval of the Class-PAGA Action Settlement,
16 it is hereby **ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** as follows:

17 1. Judgment in this matter is entered in accordance with the Court's Order Granting
18 Plaintiff's Motion for Final Approval of the Class-PAGA Action Settlement, and the
19 corresponding request for a service award, attorneys' fees and costs, administration award, and
20 Private Attorneys General Act ("PAGA") allocation ("Order Granting Final Approval") and the
21 parties' Amended Joint Stipulation of Settlement and Release ("Settlement Agreement"), which
22 are incorporated herein by this express reference as though fully set forth. Unless otherwise
23 provided herein, all capitalized terms used herein shall have the same meaning as defined in the
24 Settlement Agreement.

25 2. Consistent with the definitions provided in the Settlement Agreement, the Settlement
26 Class consists of: All current and former salaried employees of Defendant in California at any
27 time during the Class Period classified as exempt and earning less than \$100,000 annually. The
28 Settlement Class does not include any person who previously settled or released any of the

1 claims covered by this Settlement, or any other person who previously was paid or received
2 awards through civil or administrative actions for the claims covered by this Settlement.

3 3. The "Class Period" is hereby defined as the period from December 13, 2012 through
4 May 11, 2019.

5 4. This document shall constitute a Judgment for purposes of California Rules of Court,
6 Rule 3.769(h).

7 5. This "Judgment" is intended to be a final disposition of the above-captioned Class-
8 PAGA Action in its entirety and is intended to be immediately appealable.


9 6. Pursuant to California Rules of Court, Rule 3.771(b), this Judgment shall be posted
10 on the website dedicated to this action, to wit, www.parisbaguettelawsuit.com, for a period of no
11 less than thirty (30) days from the date the Court enters this Judgment.

12 7. As provided by the Order Granting Final Approval, upon entry of this Judgment by
13 the Court, and full satisfaction of all payment obligations pursuant to the Amended Stipulation of
14 Settlement and Release and Order of Final Approval, Plaintiff and all members of the Settlement
15 Class, are permanently barred and enjoined from directly or indirectly prosecuting against any of
16 the Released Claims as to the Released Parties, as defined in the Settlement Agreement.

17 8. Without affecting the finality of this Judgment, and the Order granting the Motion for
18 Final Approval of Class-PAGA Action Settlement filed concurrently herewith, pursuant to
19 California Code of Civil Procedure §664.6, this Court retains continuing and exclusive
20 jurisdiction over this Class-PAGA Action, the Parties hereto, and all Class Members. Such
21 jurisdiction shall include, but not be limited to, the interpretation, implementation and
22 enforcement of the Settlement Agreement, all Orders entered in connection therewith, as well as
23 the Judgment entered herein.

24 **IT IS SO ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED.**
