Vote **AGAINST** both proposed abortion amendments, which will be on the ballot in Nebraska in November of 2024.

Initiative #439 A vote “FOR” will amend the Nebraska Constitution to provide that all persons shall have a fundamental right to abortion until fetal viability, or when needed to protect the life or health of the pregnant patient, without interference from the state or its political subdivisions. Fetal viability is defined as the point in pregnancy when, in the professional judgment of the patient’s treating health care practitioner, there is a significant likelihood of the fetus’ sustained survival outside the uterus without the application of extraordinary medical measures.

Initiative #434 A vote “FOR” will amend the Nebraska Constitution to provide that, except when a woman seeks an abortion necessitated by a medical emergency or when the pregnancy results from sexual assault or incest, unborn children shall be protected from abortion in the second and third trimesters.

Both the pro-abortion amendment (#439) and the “pro-life” amendment (#434) would constitutionally allow most abortions in Nebraska. According to the CDC, nearly all abortions nationwide occur in the first trimester!
