



CCA FIELD TRIP POLICY

CCA provides the opportunity for students to go on many field trips during the year. All field trips require official CCA permission slips signed by the student's parent or guardian. (Handwritten permission forms are not acceptable.) A parent who is approved to be a chaperone for a school field trip may not bring other siblings or non-CCA students who are not affiliated with that trip. Parents/students who choose to drive or ride in personal vehicles are not covered under CCA liability insurance. Parent chaperones, teachers, students and/or volunteers are not permitted to drink alcohol at anytime on any CCA field trip.

All checks in grades K-12 for field trips should be made payable to CCA.

PLEASE NOTE:

Refunds are not possible once deposits/payments are remitted to the field trip companies. As per the CCA Code of Conduct, any student receiving a Level 4 suspension or higher or multiple Level 3 suspensions will automatically forfeit the privileges of all extra-curricular activities, including but not limited to, athletics, field trips, and all after school activities for the remainder of that grading period or school year and will forfeit all fees paid.
