

Risk Assessment for #GoRacingGreen Events (July 2020)

This is a **Risk Assessment** for dealing with the current Covid-19 situation related to events and tours. It is not likely to cover all scenarios that may arise, and all those attending events have the responsibility of carrying out due diligence and undertaking all instructions and procedures as advised by Debbie Matthews (or the #GoRacingGreen representative running the event) and the policies of any premises that is being visited.

Debbie Matthews has completed and passed the VisitEngland standard accreditation deeming events and tours carried out by #GoRacingGreen as "We're Good To Go" and therefore meeting all Government and Public Health guidelines.

		Adhering to Track & Trace	Names and addresses of all those attending the event will be recorded in line with Track & Trace
		Exercising stringent handwashing	Regular and appropriate handwashing must take place throughout the event.
			Professional grade, BS approved, antibacterial wipes and hand santisier (+ 70% alcohol) will be provided for use by everyone at any event where handwashing facilities may not be available.

		Wearing of face coverings and gloves	Where required by the premises that we are visiting, all those attending, unless exempt, will be asked to wear face masks and other forms of PPE deemed necessary.
		Social Distancing	All those attending the event must adhere to social distancing guidelines other than with members of their own household or support bubble.
Contamination via other objects	Items that are at risk of transferring the virus by contact	Controlling the spread of the virus	All those attending the event must not travel in the same car as anyone outside their immediate family or members of their social bubble.
			Those travelling to any event on public

	transport must please wear face masks when travelling, except for those covered by reasons of exemption.
