

ABIDE

Daily Meditation – Monday September 7, 2026

The Bible says in red letters, which means Jesus said it, “Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself unless it abides in the vine, so neither can you unless you abide in Me” (Jn. 15:4).¹ We must abide in Christ. If we do, we will find rest for our souls. He is the Branch and we are the vine.

We must abide in Him for He is our wisdom, righteousness, sanctification, and He is our redemption. He Himself will establish us. He will be with us in affliction and trial. We must abide in Christ, as He abides in the Father, obeying His commandments.

If we fully abide in Christ the Bible says, “Our joy will be complete.” We are not to sin, but to abide in Him for He is our strength. Look at the results we will get when we abide.

The Psalmist wrote, “He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the Lord, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in Him will I trust. Surely He shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, and from the noisome pestilence. He shall cover thee with His feathers, and under His wings shalt thou trust: His truth shall be thy shield and buckler” (Ps. 91:1-4). When you abide in Him, His blessings will overtake you.
