

SHARE THE BLESSING

Daily Meditation – Tuesday September 1, 2026

The Bible says, “Now the Lord said to Abram, ‘Go forth from your country, and from your relatives and from your father’s house, to the land which I will show you; and I will make you a great nation, and I will bless you, and make your name great; and so you shall be a blessing; and I will bless those who bless you, and the one who curses you I will curse. And in you all the families of the earth will be blessed” (Gen. 12:1-3).¹

It is important to note the promise God gave to Abraham. “And I will make thy seed to multiply as the stars of heaven, and will give unto thy seed all these countries; and in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed” (Gen. 26:4).

The purpose of the church is to evangelize so the local communities and the nations can receive the blessing. One of the main reasons Christians are Spirit-filled is to be witnesses to a sick and dying world (see Acts 1:8). Even if it takes rearranging their schedules, to make time, to be a witness to unbelievers so that Jesus’ ministry (He came to seek and to save that which is lost) can continue through the Body of Christ, in which they will be held accountable.

Let’s go back to Father Abraham. God informs him, “Indeed I will greatly bless you, and I will greatly multiply your seed as the stars of the heavens and as the sand which is on the seashore; and your seed shall possess the gate of their enemies” (Gen. 22:17). For the blessing to spread to individuals, family, nations, and universal salvation; He needed the Holy Spirit to come. It is the Holy Spirit’s ministry to confront and convict individuals of their sin. God will fulfill His promise to Father Abraham through the power of the Holy Spirit.

The lost need the blessing. It is their only hope. Hope is a confident expectation. The lost are putting their hope in so many things because the Bible says they are blinded by the god of this world (see 2 Cor. 4:4). Share the blessing with the lost. The Bible says, “He who wins souls is wise” (Pr. 11:30).
